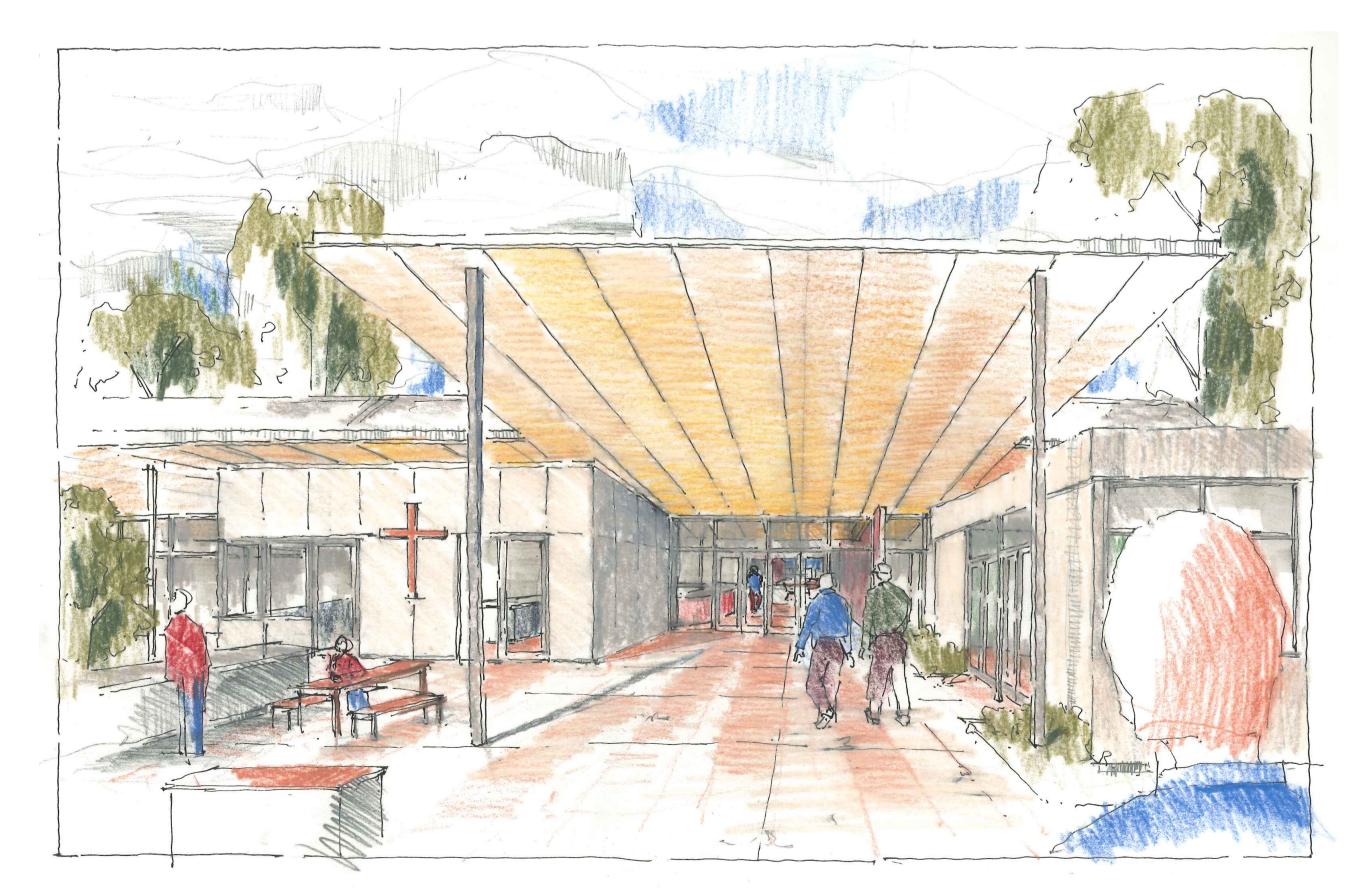
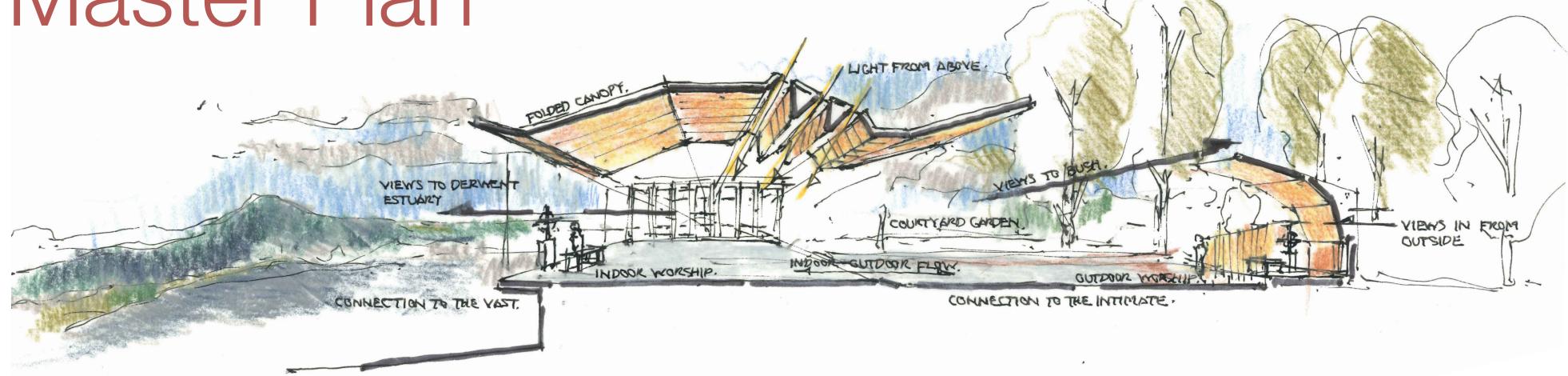
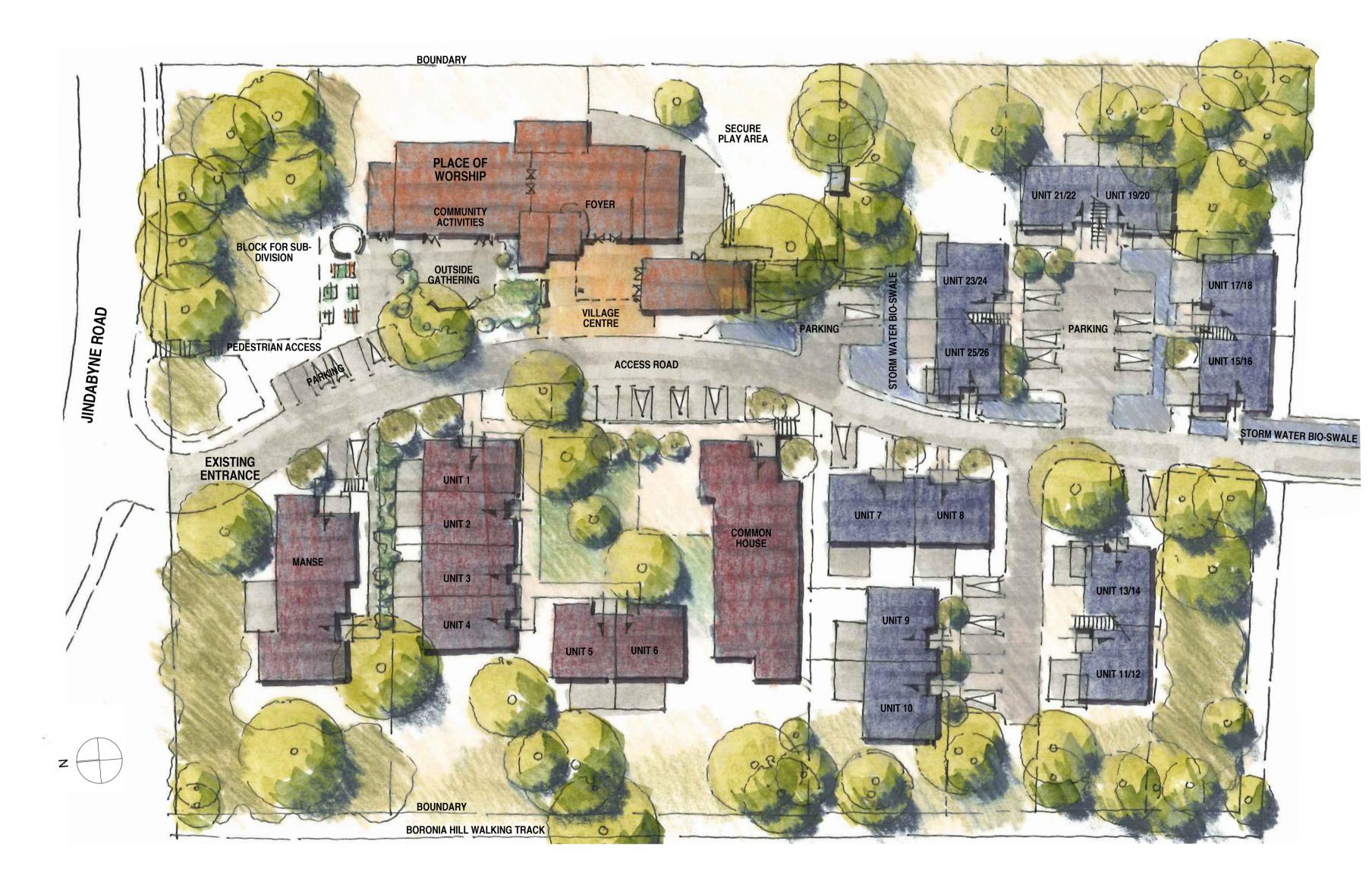


The vision of an inclusive intentional community with a strong sense of place and community is at the heart of the Rowallan Park master plan. A sound consultation process and long-term strategic planning enabled stakeholders to make astute, informed decisions regarding construction staging and facilities management as funding resources became available. It guided the successful delivery of supported housing independent living units and assisted living in a group house (Phase 1), followed by the extended and repurposed community building/place of worship and a new three bedroom manse (Phase 2). Twenty future private rental and affordable housing units will form Phase 3 of the development.

- EXTEND SERVICE INFRASTRUCTURE AS REQUIRED
